CALL FOR ENTRIES

This National Exhibition will promote wildlife artists and encourage an appreciation of Australian wildlife through artwork and sculpture.

All Australian artists are invited to submit works in the following categories:

Category 1: Two Dimensional Works

Including oil, acrylic, water media, mixed media, pencil, ink, on paper, board, canvas.

Maximum area of work (including frame) 1 metre square.

Photographic or computer generated work not accepted.

Category 2: Three Dimensional Works

Sculpture, paper, textiles, marquetry etc.

Must be able to fit through a standard doorway and not exceed 20kg weight.

Category 3: Youth Art Award

Artists must be 16 to 18 years old and may submit works that are two or three dimensional, as above.

Entries may focus only on Australian native fauna, associated environments and related conservation issues. All entries must be the original work of the artist and must be for sale. Works to be exhibited will be selected by an independent Selection Panel without reference to the artist's name. Artists will be notified of the Panel's decision by 16 March 2012.

Artists are invited to enter up to 3 works.

In recognition of excellence, art awards will be presented in each category.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- . Works selected must be framed or mounted to a professional standard with Title, Artist's name and selling price fixed to the back.
- . A 25% commission will be deducted from sold works with money to be directed to Wildlife and Botanical Artists Incorporated.
- . All entries must be the original work of the artist and not copied or reproduced in part or whole from any other artist's work. Work must not have been previously exhibited in Canberra.
- .The decision of the Selection Panel will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The Exhibition Committee reserves the right to reject work not truly represented by its submitted image. Inclusion of selected work and the manner of exhibition of works will be at the sole discretion of the Committee.
- . The Exhibition Committee reserves the right to reproduce images of entered work for the purpose of promoting the exhibition 'Wildlife Art @ Discovery'.
- .The Exhibition Committee and Wildlife and Botanical Artists Incorporated take no responsibility for uncollected work or loss or damage in transit or custody.

1. Completed entry form, GST Declaration and Artist's Declaration
2. Stamped self-addressed A4 envelope
3. One quality A4 colour photograph of each work
4. Short description or notes about work (up to 100 words)
5. Artists Biography (up to 1 A4 page)
6. Entry fee - \$ 15 for each work entered (non-refundable)
